



While Maquoketa may be small-in-size, it boasts a growing base of industries and opportunity. In the past decade, Maquoketa has welcomed the state-of-the-art Ohnward Fine Arts Center, the Hurstville Interpretive Center, a family YMCA, a \$1.5 million Clinton Community College Maquoketa Center, and the Clinton Engines Museum, among other attractions.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

he Jackson County Economic Alliance (JCEA) facilitates, leads, and promotes organized economic growth to improve the quality of life and to protect and create jobs through innovative and conventional programs within the community. Based in Maquoketa, the JCEA works to permanently bolster the economic climate in the city and throughout Jackson County.

The largest industries in Maquoketa are health care and social assistance, manufacturing, and retail trade. The area also has many people involved in agriculture, whether they are farmers or people working in an

The organization also promotes area


businesses and industries through Manufacturing Month events and career and hiring events.

THE HEART OF TOWN: BUSINESS, CULTURE AND RECREATION MEET

aquoketa has two major business districts – Main Street running north to south and the Platt Street Corridor running east to west. Along those routes are restaurants, a brewery, antique shops, a boutique hotel, dental and doctor's offices, gas stations, pharmacies, retail shops, veterinarians, dog grooming and daycare services, chiropractors, a dry cleaner, beauty salons and spas, furniture and flooring stores, law offices, insurance agents, hardware and grocery stores, banks, financial advisors and more.

The center of the downtown area is the Greenspace at the corner of South Main Street and East Pleasant Street. This public space hosts concerts and other outdoor events and is anchored by "Gables," a public art piece designed by Maquoketa native and Chicagobased architect Daniel Caven and built by local contractor Schueller & Sons.

The Greenspace is the site of many community events during the year, including the Fireball: Bash on the Ash, hosted by the Maquoketa Firefighter's Association, as well as a Summer Concert Series. Some events spill into the surrounding streets, such as the annual Maqtoberfest celebration, which features live music as well as foods, meals, crafts, and other items made or grown locally.

Just across the street from the Greenspace is the Maquoketa Art Experience (Maquoketa-art.org) at 124 S. Main St. The venue displays artwork, hosts public workshops for

people of all ages, and offers other types of fine arts programs, such as the Layers of Maquoketa Coffeehouse several times a year and productions by the Peace Pipe Players (peacepipeplayers.net), a community theater group. The MAE also has a


baby grand piano and features expanded musical offerings.

Also near the Greenspace at 121 S. Olive St. is the Old City Hall Gallery (oldcityhallgallery.com), which features the work and studio space dedicated to the work of renowned artists

Maquoketa native Rose Frantzen and Charles Morris, her husband.

Appreciation for the arts extends beyond the downtown to the Ohnward Fine Arts Center (ohnwardfineartscenter.com). Located at 1215 E. Platt St., the Center includes







an 844-seat theater that hosts concerts, cultural events, plays, comedians, and regional art displays.

Programs for all ages and interests abound at the Maquoketa Public Library (Maquoketa.lib.ia.us), a Carnegie structure that opened in 1904. The beautiful building at 126 S.2nd St. houses books, computers, a history room, audio books, DVDs and many other resources. A summer reading program and a monthly book club are just a few of the offerings. The library's children section boasts many

activities to foster creativity, including puppets, games and puzzles, interactive computer programs, story time, and more. The Friends of the Library (maquoketa.lib.ia.us/friends) also hosts








activities throughout the year, including used book sales.

Maquoketa's 61 Drive-in Theater (61-driveintheatre.com) is one of the handful of drive-in theaters in Iowa and a modern historical relic. You can

catch a movie indoors on one of the three screens at the Voy III Theatre (voytheatres.com), located at 207 S. Main St.

Visitors to Maquoketa Brewing can enjoy a locally brewed beer. The taproom

is a popular gathering spot, also offering ciders, seltzers, wine and old-fashioned Coca-Cola. Family friendly (with juice boxes for kids), the business also features an event space. It has a limited menu, and guests are also welcome to bring snacks













or order food from local restaurants. (maqbrew.com) Located in the lower level

Located in the lower level of the historic Decker Hotel, built in 1875, the refurbished Maquoketa Cave is another place to enjoy food and drink, as well as karaoke, music performances and comedy. (deckerhousehotel.com)





OTHER ATTRACTIONS AND ONE-OF-A-KIND AMENITIES

Maquoketa is a city rich in history and an appreciation for its agricultural and industrial roots. It also celebrates the beauty of the natural landscape, from limestone bluffs and winding waterways to scenic prairie and thriving woodlands. Its' many one-of-a-kind amenities reflect a diversity of life and commitment to community.



The **Maquoketa Municipal Airport** has eight T-hangars that are available for rent plus the community hangar with up to five spaces. It is operated by the Maquoketa Airport Commission. (maquoketaia.com/airport/)

The interactive displays at the Clinton Engines Museum tell the story of Clinton Engines Corp., one of the world's leading producers of small gasoline engines. The site yielded over 18 million engines, making the company Iowa's 10th largest employer and drawing workers from more than 33 communities in three states. Clinton engines were used around the world on hundreds of different machines. The museum, located at 607 E. Maple St., is also the place where people can go to do genealogical research as it is the home of the Jackson County Research **Genealogical Chapter.** It also features the **LaMotte Depot** on its grounds. This restored station is a real gem that harkens back to 1910. (clintonengines. com)

From mid-May to mid-October, fresh produce, baked goods, meals, music, and education are on tap at the **Maquoketa Farmers Market** from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. in the Ohnward Fine Arts Center parking lot, 1215 E. Platt St.

Food vendors and live music make the market a community experience where people can stock up on locally produced food and enjoy the outdoors with friends and neighbors. Patrons also enjoy local wine, root
beer, jellies and an occasionally
expanded selection of booths
featuring arts and crafts vendors.

Just a short drive away is the unique music venue **Codfish Hollow Barn-stormers** (codfishhollowbarnstormers.com).

The owners have turned the old barn into a space for performers of all genres, and there is food, camping and art onsite. Open to all ages, Codfish Hollow hosts local and national indie bands. It's located at 5013 288th Ave.

Hurstville Interpretive Center

gives visitors a chance to learn about woodlands, prairies, wetlands, and history with more than 20 activities and exhibits. Part of **Jackson County Conservation**, the center is staffed with environmental educators who can answer questions about your natural

surroundings and more. The center, located at 18670 63rd St., hosts indoor and outdoor programs and activities year-round. It has activities for people of all ages.

Hurstville Lime Kilns is a three-acre historic site featuring a roadside rest area with a picnic shelter. Interpretive signage tells visitors the story of the kilns, and a stairway allows people to walk up around the kilns. Tours are available to groups or families upon request. Contact the Jackson County Conservation office at (563) 652-3783 to schedule a tour with an education staff member.



Jackson County Historical Museum is located at Pearson Memorial Center on the Jackson County Fairgrounds, 1212 E. Quarry St. The 22,000-square-foot space has two floors of displays that show agriculture, industry, business, education, and personal history of Jackson County. Information about the museum is available from the **Jackson County Historical Society** (jciahs.com).

A newer addition to the city is the Jackson County Veterans
Memorial Park at 112 E. Jefferson St., which was built to honor personnel from the five service branches. The Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, and Coast Guard are represented on the five colored markers and flags flying high above them at the northernmost point of the

memorial.
Maquoketa has two active veterans groups: Timber City American Legion
Post 75 and Veterans of Foreign

Wars Post 3633 and Auxiliary.





HISTORY



he name Maquoketa was derived from the river that flows just north of the city and means in the Indian language "Bear River." This stream was known by the Indians as maquaweutaw meaning "there are bears." At that time, there were a great number of

bears which inhabited its banks and the streams that fed the river.

Although the spelling evolved to Maquoketa, the original plat showed the name as Makoketa, and records kept by postal clerks show that mail has been received and delivered with Maquoketa spelled more than a thousand ways.

Maquoketa has been known as the "Timber City" since about 1870 because of the many trees that line the streets. In January 1838, J. E. Goodenow and Lyman Bates from upper New York state headed west with a wagonload of trade goods.

They crossed the frozen Mississippi

HISTORY




River and settled at the future site of Maquoketa. Goodenow and Bates had joined the steady stream of settlers migrating west into the vast lands of the Louisiana Purchase. In 1839, other settlers mostly from New York, arrived at the new settlement. That same year, Goodenow built a corn cracker, and in 1842 a flour mill was constructed. Goodenow later built a brick oven, a pot kiln for making brick lime for mortar. The town's location on the post road between Dubuque and Davenport made it a popular rest stop for pioneers heading west.

In 1840, Goodenow established a post office under the name Springfield. The name already had been claimed by other communities, however, and the Post Office Department requested a change. On March 3, 1844, the town officially became

Maquoketa. The town was incorporated in 1853 with a population of 300.

In 1854, the first fair was sponsored by the Agricultural Association. That same year, W.C. Swigart published the Jackson Sentinel, and the Maquoketa Excelsior was established two years later. The city's efforts to attract rail service were rewarded in 1870 when the first train chugged into town. In 1873 Maquoketa became the permanent seat of Jackson County. The Decker House and the 800-seat Harris Opera House were built in 1876. A disastrous fire in 1882 prompted the establishment of a volunteer fire department and construction of a brick firehouse in 1901.

Over the years Maquoketa's industrial concerns have included a woolen mill, a brewery, furniture builder, a cigar maker, wagon and pump makers, and foundries.


HEALTH CARE


ackson County Regional Health Center (JCRHC) has provided healthcare and wellness programs since 1949, and a new \$37.2 million campus that opened in 2021 will continue that legacy for years to come.


The state-of-the-art, publicly owned facility surrounded by native prairie is bordered on its south side by U.S. Highway 61, making it possibly the most visually prominent public landmark in Jackson County. The 25-acre campus features 28,000 square feet divided between two levels, a navigation-friendly design and medical services befitting a small-market community on the move.

Patient services include surgery, radiology, lab, specialty clinics, pharmacy, inpatient care and skilled care, physical therapy and rehabilitation, diagnostic imaging and 24/7 emergency care. The hospital is licensed for 25 beds. A caring, expert staff attest to the hospital's motto: Better health starts here. (jcrhc.org)



he Maquoketa Community School District is located about halfway between Dubuque (to the north) and Davenport (to the south). It serves about 1,333 students in four buildings, which consist of two elementary buildings, one middle school, and one high school. After sixth grade, it serves students from Sacred Heart

Elementary School in Maquoketa, as well as students from Delwood Elementary and Andrew Elementary, which are in neighboring districts.


Sacred Heart Catholic School is a private school serving students through sixth grade. According to its mission statement: Sacred Heart School is a strong faith community which provides a God-centered learning environment that promotes stewardship and 21st century skills as we form the whole person. Maquoketa also offers several daycare and preschool centers including Sunshine Preschool & Daycare (sunshinemaquoketa.org), Sacred Heart Preschool and Childcare (sacredheartmaq. org), Little Shepherd Christian Preschool (Little Shepherd Preschool/Day Care on Facebook) and Head Start Center (hacap.org).






